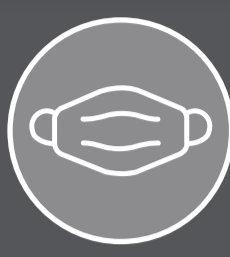

Optum testing resources for employers



Optum does not consider COVID-19 testing a *requirement* for a return-to-office strategy



Masking, physical distancing, proper hygiene, and isolation are primary protection measures



Testing is appropriate in certain circumstances, such as work environments where:

Physical distancing is not possible

Virus exposure is prevalent

Contact with high-risk individuals is prevalent

Community infections are high or increasing

**All testing is conducted at employer discretion. Optum return-to-office strategy is based on CDC guidelines.*

REASON FOR TESTING: PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE

Screenings conducted daily



Screenings include daily telephonic pre-screening and temperature checks

ON-SITE TESTING AND SCREENING

Testing count: 4-8K employees/week
Regions: New York, California, Georgia
Workplace environment: Entertainment production
Risk of exposure: High



Negative test required for employee to enter facility



Ad hoc testing for employees who have been in contact with a diagnosed individual within 14 days

REASON FOR TESTING:

PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE AND COMMUNITY INFECTIONS ARE HIGH OR INCREASING

LARGE EMPLOYER



ON-SITE TESTING AND SCREENING

Testing count: ~437 tests/day across 4 locations
Regions: Ohio, Iowa, Texas, Arizona
Workplace environment: Field workers & call centers
Risk of exposure: High

Employees returned in a phased process



Deployed testing for phase 1 within 30 days of initial discussion



Negative test required for employee to return to worksite



Real-time data provided to employer from Optum data platform



Employer has field staff who are easily exposed



Employer has call centers of essential workers in COVID-19 hotspot areas
