ED use is on the rise and so is spend

ED visits are projected to increase 11.2%, rising from 143 million in 2018 to 159 million by 2030.1

ED cost per visit can be upward of \$1,250 to \$2,000 depending on the line of business versus \$200 to \$300 per visit for lower-cost alternatives.

Health plans may have limited success deploying point solutions that focus exclusively on retrospective lookback of utilization to drive member interventions.
